This Notice of Laboratory Decommissioning is required for any laboratory space when the principal investigator (PI) or Responsible Person is 1) leaving Texas A&M AgriLife, 2) moving to another AgriLife Center, 3) relocating to another laboratory within the same building, or 4) removing specific hazards (e.g., radiological, biological, and lasers). Notification is also required for laboratory spaces undergoing renovation or if an alternate PI/Researcher is taking over the space.
