

## Date: 7/17/14 TITLE: Standard Operating Procedure for Employee Safety Training

### Revised: 12/18/19

### 1. Introduction:

Texas A&M AgriLife Research and the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service must provide safety training to all employees to ensure that employees can perform all required job duties safely. It is the responsibility of the hiring supervisor/immediate supervisor/project leader to determine the necessary training for each employee, verify the training has been completed, and maintain training records.

## 2. Determining Proper Training:

Employees must receive appropriate training before performing their jobs in the workplace, when procedures change, or when new hazards are introduced. Proper training is required to ensure all personnel are informed of hazards associated with their work. The supervisor is responsible for identifying training needs of an employee. Trainings are offered through TrainTraq, internally, or can be requested through the AgriLife safety coordinator.

## 3. Documentation of Training

All safety trainings shall be documented and records shall be available upon request. Training documentation (<u>form</u> <u>D001</u>) are provided on the EHS website under the Program tab, AgriLife Safety or click <u>here</u>. TrainTraq trainings are electronically documented.

The Hazard Communication Training record (<u>form D002</u>) must be completed in addition to the Hazard Communication (11020) TrainTraq course for employees who work with hazardous chemicals.
